

### **Welding Program Options**

The Welding Technology Program at Modesto Technical College has three (3) training options for your to choose from. Each of the options builds on the skills mastered in the lower level options. The options are:

**CPW I** - 20 weeks long with your choice of 2 Certifications **CPW II** - 30 weeks long with your choice of 3 Certifications **CPW III** - 40 weeks long with your choice of 4 Certifications


CPW I Includes: SMAW - Arc Welding on mild steel, GMAW- Mig Welding on mild steel, and GTAW - Tig Welding on Stainless Steel Tubing. Shop skills such as Plasma Arc cutting, layout and blue print reading are included.

CPW II includes all of CPW I plus: Innershield Welding on Structural Steel; and pipe Welding on 6 inch steel pipe.

CPW III includes all of the skills in CPW I and CPW II plus: Mig Welding on Stainless Steel and on Aluminum.

C;asses are held from 8am until 3pm Monday through Thursday.





## Modesto's Top Welding School


